- International sports movement for mothers of all ages and women over 30 (origins in Israel)
- The game: Cachibol (simplified version of volleyball)
- Part of the CSIT World Sports Games
- Social aspects:
 - Networking
 - Sense of community (integration & inclusion)
 - Promoting health







Refugees in MAMANE MANANE MANA

- Issue: Sport is not accessible to all women...
 - ...due to financial & family conditions
 - ...due to religious backgrounds
 - ...especially for women with migrational background
- Therefore Mamaned Austria is addressing women and children directly
- Training sessions in "protected environments" (no men allowed) directly in refugee homes



Integration & Inclusion: Integration Team

- Women can find appreciation, a joyful distraction from the often difficult daily life, gain self confidence and are willing to make changes in their environment as well as to take on other role models
- Up to 20 different refugee groups train up to 3 times a week and a possibility to play in the Mamanet League Austria
- Some women had never played sports before and became important players in their teams
- Participation of an Integration Team at the CSIT WSG 2021 thanks to financial support of the Austrian Ministry of Sport and the organizational support of ASKÖ







Integration & Inclusion: Mamanet Coaches

- 14 women with refugee backgrounds have already completed the official Mamanet Austria Coach Education
- Takes place once a year at the Sports University Vienna
- Positive effects:
 - Earning some money and gaining independence
 - Own Mamanet email address & bank account
 - Social exchange in Mamanet leads to changes in lifes
 - Positive discourse on "headscarf" many women took it of







Integration & Inclusion: Mamanet Coaches

 Mamanet Austria also supports asylum procedures for women, who take regularly part in the Mamanet courses and include themselves positively
